#### Our Club:-

I have been over here in Galicia, Spain for the last six months. Food, tapas, wine and entertainment have been fantastic, even the weather has been fairly good. Firstly, being on a bike here is not really common. The cities are densely packed, public transport is generally good and people have remembered how to walk from place to place.

Secondly, they are not many of the older type bikes on the road. A few Harleys, the odd older BMW even one CX500 (!) But, the big change from four years ago is that there are a lot of the bigger modern bikes eg BMW especially 1200 GS, Guzzi,s, a Triumph (and scooters, if you can call them bikes).





. The first American 750 motor. Excelsior the 3<sup>rd</sup> US manufacturer after Harley and Indian that also made the Henderson 4 but the owner, Schwimm, also made pushbikes and when the depression hit he shut down the motorcycle production thinking more people able to afford the treddlies. Never started with the motorbikes again but still making pushbikes. The most desirable SuperX models are from 29 -31 and when these come up you would have to have about \$80kUS to get a look in. '25 was the first year of SuperX production and about 1500 made. Indian had to follow with the 101, 750 model and a couple of years later Harley buckled and followed suit producing their own 750s. The designer actually worked for Harley but they told him the 750 motor would never catch on so he took his bat, ball and design and went to Schwimm.


The design of the Super X was a considerable departure from its predecessors at Excelsior. Where earlier Excelsiors had an enclosed primary chain transmitting power from the engine to a separate gearbox, the Super X had the engine and transmission together in a single crankcase, using a helical gear to power the transmission directly from the engine. The Super X also marked the return of leading-link forks on Excelsior motorcycles, which had earlier switched to trailing-link forks similar to those used by Indian but with coil springs instead of Indian's quarter-elliptic leaf springs.

#### **ANNUAL AFFILIATIONS**

- CHMC has changed the timing for the payment of Clubs Annual Affiliation fees and submission of annual Census.
- Affiliation Fees are now due on 31st December each year.
- Because some Clubs may not have received all of their members renewals by 31st December,
   Affiliation fees and vehicle numbers will now be calculated from the numbers for the year preceding.
- This means that the 2020 Affiliation Fees will be calculated on the number of members in the 2019 year.
- It also means that vehicle numbers for the 2020 Census will be those for the 2019 Year.
- Clubs may now pay Affiliation Fees either by cheque (as in the past) or Direct Deposit
- When paying by Direct Deposit, please note the Club initials and "2020 Fees" with the transaction.
- If paying by Direct Deposit, the Census Form may be returned to the Secretary either by email or surface mail, but must still be returned.
- The Affiliation and Census Form for 2020 is attached and also available from the CHMC Website under <a href="http://www.heritagemotoringcouncil.org.au/PUBLICATIONS.php">http://www.heritagemotoringcouncil.org.au/PUBLICATIONS.php</a>.
- Forms will also be available at the Mid Term Meeting at Newcastle on October 26th

#### REGISTRATION REMINDER STICKERS



- Clubs should have received, by mail or from the AGM in Griffith, a bundle of Registration Reminder stickers
- CHMC is providing these *free of charge to members*. Council's Committee considered these stickers were a simple way of checking when registration is due.
- The stickers are for use on all registered vehicles owned by members, including modern vehicles, not
  just historic or classic vehicles.
- If your Club requires more Rego Reminder stickers please have your club Secretary or CHMC Delegate advise the CHMC Secretary.
  - Sticker Application Instructions: (Stickers have a residue free adhesive).
    - Peel the backing away from the label (not the label away from the backing).
    - Use thumb or finger to remove backing, do not use your fingernails.
    - Peel from any straight edge, do not peel from the corners as this will burr the label.


