There's no question that the logbook scheme has had a major impact on historic vehicle clubs. From screening, responding to, and processing, increased numbers of enquiries and applications to trying to evolve the club

so that it still holds a strong club culture going forward.

We're planning for more registration days this year and will be locking in all the registration days well in advance for 2022. Speaking of registration, have you ever thought about how it works when you privately visit a registration officer for an inspection? It's a very singular thing that does nothing for club cohesion and solidarity. Yes, it's okay but central to belonging to a club is spending time together as a club. Year after year some people remain invisible even when there's a club event. Think about that for a minute. It's important.

There's a registration day next month and it's another way for members to catch up for a yarn as a group. You don't have to be registering a bike to come along. When we meet as a group we grow as a group. Not everyone can make it on that day (myself included unfortunately) but hopefully some members can drop in and say g'day.

Another change is that our webmaster, Dieter, has created a new NRCMCC Facebook group for members to come together in a common place to post and comment about *stuff* (technical term ;-)). It's monitored and moderated so, hopefully, we should be able to keep it relevant. Give it a try, post your topics on it and let's see how it goes as a club. Also from the President –this email was sent to members on 13th May

After feedback from members the current Facebook page has been revamped to better meet the needs of the members.

Our very talented webmaster, Dieter, has created a new group under the current FaceBook page. If you go to the Facebook page and look at the "Groups" tab in there you will find the new group.

Why a new group?

- Access is by invitation only.

- It is a moderated group and spam, porn and other off topic subjects can be removed.
- Once you join the group you will be able to post and comment on ride reports, photos and ask other group members for advice etc. Your posts and comments are all visible on the front page
- It's early days but this is a better platform for intraclub communication.

Give it a go, send in a request to join and see if it works for you as it develops over time.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR MOTORCYCLES on the Historic Vehicle Scheme (HVS):

Motorcycles must be as CLOSE TO ORIGINAL CONDITION as possible with NO ALTERATIONS except for safety features, such as rear view mirrors & turn indicators and must be over 30 years old.

Motorcycle Usage:

NRCMCC members are permitted to participate in Club events listed on the NRCMCC webpage, at NRCMCC.org, without having to make an entry in their logbook.

Members that are on the RMS logbook scheme must fill their logbook for each day's use if it is not a club event.

A logbook entry is required for maintenance rides (eg test runs) & personal use and the logbook should be carried with you while riding the bike.

The log book can be used as soon as it's issued to record the days you use the bike. The number of days allocated for use depends on the remaining length of conditional registration when the log book is issued.

Only one person is required to record the daily use of the motorcycle. If there are multiple riders on the same day, the initial rider on the day must complete the line entry for that day.

Carrying a Club Magazine /Events Listing and a current Membership Card/Receipt, while not a HVS requirement, is regarded as a worthwhile practice.





"Some offices have Casual Friday. We thought Motorcycle Friday was a much better idea."







05th May Club ride






