

From the Presidents Chair

Welcome to 2022 and the club meeting proceeding as normal 8th March at 7.30pm at Clunes Memorial Hall Walker St Clunes will be our first meeting of the year and we are hoping to see many friends who we have missed.

The memorial ride on Sunday 13th of February to Evans Head was well attended and I thank Peter Lake for his organisation and Peter Harvey and others who spoke in remembrance of those club members no longer with us. Thank you to all who attended.

It has been a different past few years with all of the restrictions with many, understandably being very careful not to get infected. The boarders are open and we are able to attend the QLD rallies and rides that we were attending in the past. We need not to be complacent and to know that we can now just about guarantee that we will suffer some symptoms and at some time be in contact with infected people. So be on your guard so as not to spread Covid. Many of our members are over fifty and are susceptible and may suffer major medical complications even life threatening. To minimise the risk for us all is follow medical advice, be vaccinated follow safety measures put in place. If you are unvaccinated, or have been in close contact with positive people (less than 7 days) or have symptoms please think of your fellow member and make the decision to not attend meetings or events. Do your part in keeping everyone healthy and safe.

The times where we were unable to ride interstate are now past so now is the time to dust off your ride and join with friends and club members and motivated to get out and ride. You may also have undertaken a restoration and are keen to trial it so let's get out and ride.

31st March is our cut off date for your membership. A Reminder that for a HISTORIC PLATE to be Valid you MUST be a CURRENT and PAID up member. This is not a club requirement, but it is the law. REMEMBER you will be without your CTP insurance if you are NOT a paid member. I read somewhere that some riders are folding their conditional registration certificate to show the rego number, make etc and placing in their old rego holders. I have also seen some riders place theirs in a zip lock bag with rego number, make etc showing and tap it under their seat. I thought these are good ideas if you have several machines.

The decision to run rallies has seen many changes to these events with some clubs choosing to cancel rallies held early in the year with others going ahead with changed formats especially where food is involved. I would like for us to hold our Club rally in September. so we need to think about this now so we can organise our great event.


Method 2: Snail Mail.

Method 3*: In person at a monthly meeting - the club's least preferred option

Complete a membership renewal form beforehand and hand it to the Membership Officer at the next available club meeting. Then pay the Treasurer your fees - cash, cheques or MOs. *Please Note that Covid 19 restrictions may still be with us in 2022 and there may not be any meetings held before 31st March 2022. Therefore your ability to pay and submit your form by Method 3 may not be an option. You should use method 1 or 2 in order to pay & submit your form by 31st March 2022.

Thunderbolts Way 18th BSA National Rally



October 21-23 Gloucester 2022

Fellow Motorcyclist,

Please accept this invitation to you and your club members to attend the 18th BSA National Rally in Gloucester, NSW, from October 21st to the 23rd, 2022.

As a club registered with the NSW RMS for conditional registration, this invitation allows your members' vehicles, registered under similar systems in NSW & other states, to be legally ridden to and at this event.

Due to the various COVID restrictions that can be imposed with a moment's notice, we have decided to change the format from the usual fully catered event to a self-catered style, as the NSW government could apply venue capacity restrictions without warning, rendering prepaid large collective meals illegal.

The venue for the rally is the Gloucester Holiday Park (contact details below) and because of the aforementioned potential COVID restrictions, we will not be holding cabins for clubs or individuals as has been done previously, so please book directly with the park, details below.

There will be a short ride on Friday afternoon, the long main ride on Saturday, which includes a group photo shoot, and two short rides on Sunday morning and afternoon. As with previous Nationals, the Saturday run will terminate with a Concours near the starting point and will include a happy hour for drinks. Following that, there will be a presentation dinner at the nearby club with optional dinner (prepaid).

Trophies will also be awarded for longest distance ridden to the rally on a BSA by male and female riders (pillions excluded) plus longest distance travelled for those without sufficient time to enjoy riding their BSAs from far distant locations.

We look forward to sharing some quality BSA time with fellow BSA owners or enthusiasts.

While Concours participation is restricted to BSAs, attendance at the rally by any motorcycle is welcomed.

Rally entry forms will be out in April in time for the All British Rally (should it be allowed to happen this year) and Gloucester Holiday Park are taking bookings as of now.




