
Mary has already mentioned that our sponsors have continued to support the club after most were devastated themselves by the February/March floods






Hydrogen cars are still a way off in Australia for the mainstream but they may become the real "clean" cars of the future due to their zero carbon footprint and cost effective motoring. Did you know they clean the air as they motor along? Did you know the hydrogen is used to power an electric type engine in these vehicles? EV's (electric vehicles) are good but there have toxic batteries to dispose of at the end of their lives and we use coal to produce the power to charge them at the moment so it's not that environmentally clean really.

I recently did a vehicle launch for Hyundai in Sydney and saw that they have a hydrogen cell filling station at their main headquarters in Ryde. It's a small low pressure filling station mainly used for hydrogen test vehicles as there is only a handful of hydrogen cars in all of Sydney. Hyundai are however looking towards the future and are about to replacing their low pressure hydrogen tank with a new self contained on site high pressure hydrogen generator and storage module. It will use the solar power off their rooftop PV solar system to power the module that will produce hydrogen from just water and store it on site. They can not only use this hydrogen to fuel hydrogen cell cars but can also use it to power a generator to produce electricity at any time of the day or night. This power can stored or be used to charge EV's and/or run their entire business on this "free" and clean electricity. Once installed, it's a free power loop using solar as the principal power source and water to produce hydrogen. Now that's pretty cool. By Michael Smith.
