

Rob writes (The Monaltrie accident saga - continued).

Well, I decided to submit x5 photos via e-mail [shot just after the 9.15am accident on my son's phone] as evidence against the Ford Ranger driver to Shannons insurance, after other driver's fanciful aspersions of the full blame she put on myself.

These photos came with a full A4 page of the complete stage-by-stage analysis of "my" accident on Riverbank/ Wyrallah Rds intersection, plus a close-up of the exact impact spot and damage to RHS of my Can-Am 'Ryker' sent as evidence to Shannon's accident Investigators.

It strongly pointed to the all too common "didn't see him" excuse by the Ranger driver, corner-cutting & hitting me on the RHS in a sem-frontal side-swipe impact - rather than as she claimed to NRMA - it was me "driving into her". Her allegation was maintained despite my twin side-lights being permanently on, twin driving-lights ditto and RHS front indicators on, all while stationary.

So surely I could never be invisible? Wrong! But I am pleased to report that I have now been refunded by Shannons over the \$500 Excess, plus given replacement helmet (as my 'Nolan' had the rear LHS-side damaged via contact with the sealed road after being spun 270 degrees on impact.)

My 'take-away" from this bad experience includes: Leatt's neck-braces may be a bother, but they do work in preventing neck injuries, so does kevlar/soft joint-armour and full riding gear, plus of course a good helmet. I guess however careful you are personally, predation accidents via cars/truck drivers often happen due to ignorance, distractions, poor road-skills and generally negligent driving.

On the brighter side, my next ride is already purchased via some of the write-off money, still to come from Geelong Vic. It is an old 2015 BRP Can-Am 'Spyder' RSS SE5 with their original 1,000cc Vee-twin engine in shocking (but hopefully very visible?) 'Californian' green/white/red-combination colours.

Also in future I will be wearing a light-weight 'Rally-Marshall' type overcoat (in "Australian Traditional Costume" fluorescent-yellow - of course).

Perhaps next time an excuse of "I didn't see him your Honour" or "He drove into me" simply won't wash and they may have to admit their driving error?

Some pious hope - eh! Safe riding everyone. R.A
