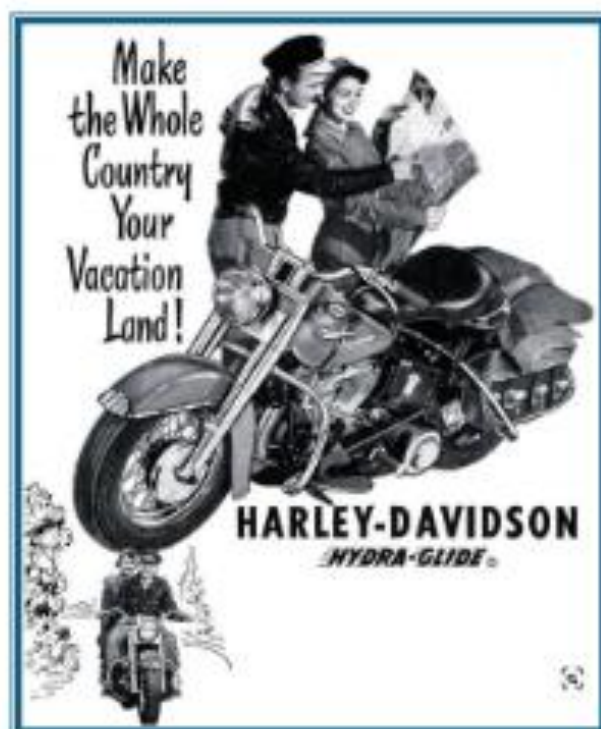

Conditions of entry: The motorcycle/s listed above **must** be 30years or older, currently registered on full or historic vehicle registration or have an approved RMS permit, and be in safe working order. The rider must hold a current motorcycle rider's licence. The entrant must ride in a safe manner and adhere to road traffic rules. The entrant must comply with directions of the marshals. We retain the right to refuse an entry.

In the event of a breakdown: The back-up will not wait while you make roadside repairs. Once the back-up vehicle reaches you, just have your bike transported to the next stop where you can attempt a repair if you wish. If you do decline to be transported, *you will be on your own*. You must be a registered entrant to the rally or a member of the Coffs Harbour Motorcycle Restorers' Club to use the back-up trailer with first preference to entrants.

In the event of an accident: Stay together and wait for a marshal, then if unable to help, move on.


