
Sunday 15th July Ride to Brunswick Heads 7 or 8 riders enjoyed the hot rods





Removal of registration labels

Vehicles registered under the Conditional Registration Scheme are no longer required to display a registration label. The Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2017 was amended on 1 July 2018 and the requirement to display a label was removed. This means you will no longer receive a label with your registration certificate.

Labels for light vehicles have not been required since 2013 and recent national changes have abolished registration labels for heavy vehicles.

Displaying labels after 1 July 2018

Although there is no legal requirement for vehicles registered under the Conditional Registration Scheme to display a label from 1 July 2018, there is also no requirement for labels to be removed. You may leave existing labels on your vehicles if you wish.

Additionally, it is no longer an offence to display an expired label.

FAQs

Why have registration labels for Conditional vehicles been abolished?

Labels for light vehicles have not been required since 2013 and recent national changes have abolished registration labels for heavy vehicles.

How will police know if my vehicle is registered if there is no label?

NSW Police use number plate recognition cameras to automatically detect if a vehicle is registered or unregistered. Fixed enforcement cameras can also detect unregistered vehicles.

How will I know when my vehicle is due for registration without a label?

You will continue to be sent registration reminder notices in the post 6 weeks prior to when your registration is due for renewal.

Why did I still receive a registration label after 1 July 2018?

Some customers may have received registration labels after 1 July 2018. This is due to our system transitioning to the new registration notice. If you received a label you are not legally required to display it on your vehicle.
